

Mini Style Guide for Bridesmaids: Bachelorette Party Edition

This mini style guide is designed to help bridesmaids coordinate, pack smart, and look amazing all weekend long. Whether you're going full glam or keeping it chill, this guide has you covered from outfit inspo to group coordination tips.

Know Your Vibe

Match your outfit choices to the bride's energy and your destination. Ask early if there are themes or color palettes. It's better to ask than to show up off-theme in neon when everyone else is in blush satin.

Core Looks to Pack

- Day outfit: brunch, travel, casual exploring
- Night outfit: dinner, club, photo ops
- Theme outfit: check for any matching nights
- Swimsuit + cover-up (if pool or beach involved)
- One 'just in case' outfit
- Comfy shoes + dressy option

Matching Without Stressing

Coordinated colors and accessories are easier than matching full outfits. Choose a shared tone (white, black, pink, etc.) or match by vibe (glam, beachy, boho). Ask if the bride wants to stand out—often, the group wears one shade and she wears another.

Style Emergency Kit

- Double-sided fashion tape
- Mini steamer or wrinkle release spray
- Blister pads and bandaids
- Clear bag (some venues require it)
- Back-up earrings or a foldable flat

Final Style Reminders

- Don't try anything new or uncomfortable for the first time at the party.
- Pack with confidence—you don't need 12 outfits for 3 days.
- Hydrate, rest, and bring the energy. The best look is a good attitude (plus maybe a touch of shimmer).
